Growing Corn Experiment

Think you need a big field to grow corn? Think again! With just a few common household items and some corn kernels, you can be on your way to growing corn in the classroom or at hame. Just follow these simple instructions:

Materials

- 1. Five to six corn kernels
- 2. Paper towels
- 3. One sandwich-size zipper-lock bag
- 4. Water
- 5. Black markers

Instructions

- 1. Wet a paper towel completely, and then wring out excess water.
- 2. Put five to six corn kernels in the center of the paper towel. (Using this many kernels will increase the chances of sprouting.)
- 3. Put the paper towel and the kernels in the zipper-lock bag so the kernels can be seen. Close the bag and label it.
- 4. Lay the bag in a place exposed to natural daylight or a grow lamp, where you can observe it.
